*The Best Way to Predict the Future is to Create It Yourself*



Peter Diamandis, M.D., has spent his life turning impossible dreams into reality: Creating a global space university, flying the first private tourist to the International Space Station, creating a \$10 million prize to launch the personal space flight revolution, and inventing the Rocket Racing League. The X Prize competition, which he launched in 1996, prompted 26 teams from seven nations to build private space-ships. "Our objective was not simply to promote technology, but to shift a paradigm and create a new marketplace," said Diamandis. He plans to use his prize model to enable technological breakthroughs in the environment, genomics, nanotechnology, and medicine. Among his dreams, he wants to create cars that exceed 100 miles per gallon, address poverty, and cure cancer.
