

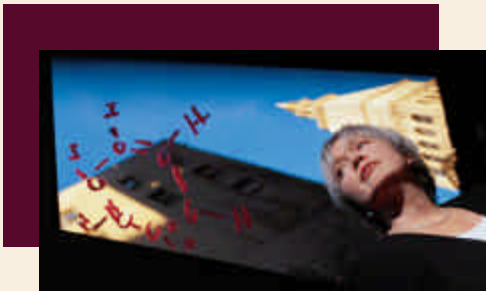

Dr. Karen Stephenson, hailed in Business 2.0 as “The Organization Woman,” is a corporate anthropologist. Discussed by Malcolm Gladwell in his best-seller *The Tipping Point*, Stephenson’s pioneering work in detecting and designing human networks has since risen to prominence. Dr. Stephenson has combined her personal legacy in the sciences with practical management experience and research to publish and lecture in the areas of the workplace, organizational culture and communication, and the management of human networks. She shows that the informal networks that exist within a business organization reveal how the organization actually functions.
